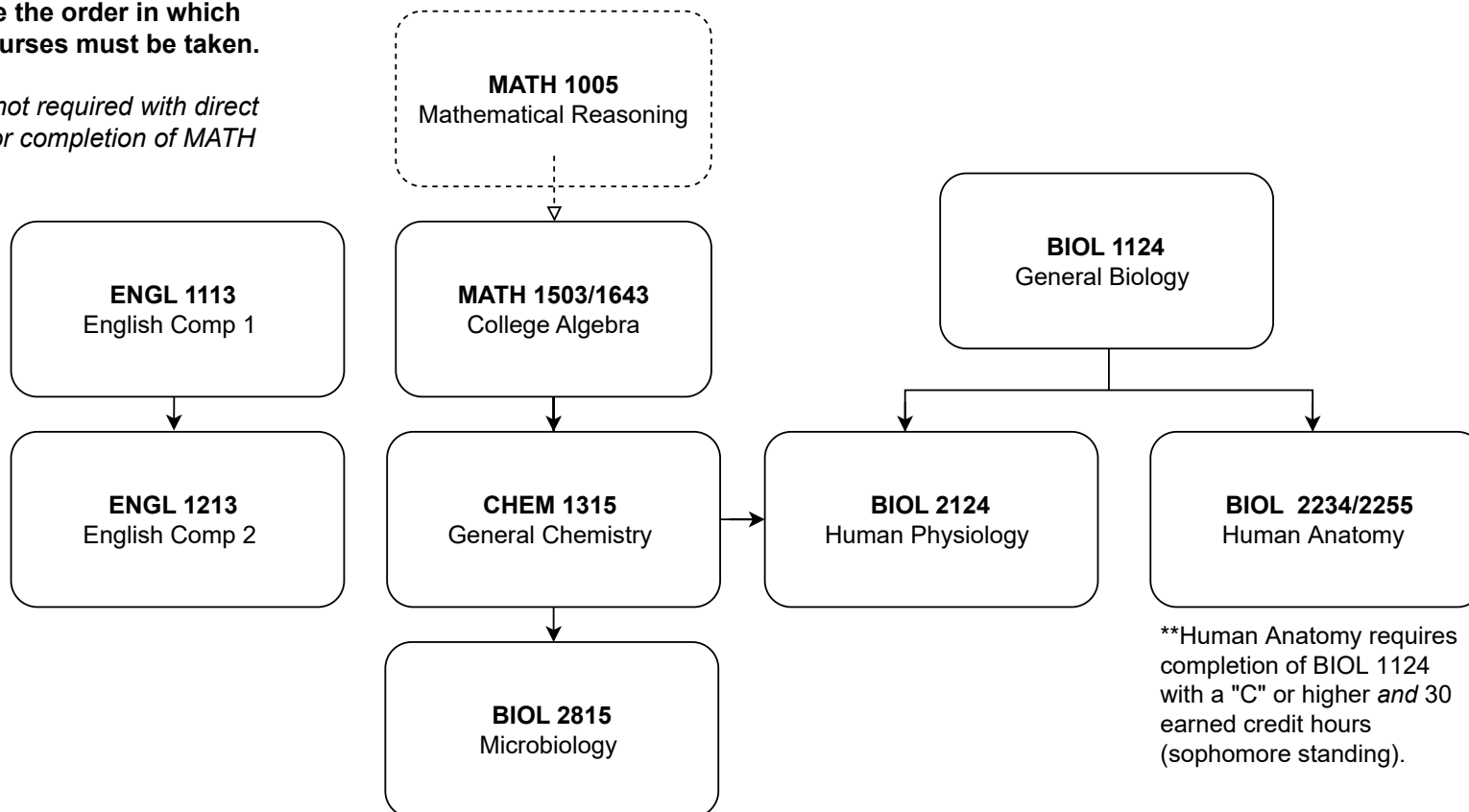
ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ☐ Completion of 60 hours of prerequisite coursework (completed prior to beginning the program)
- ☐ 30 prerequisite hours must be completed prior to application
- ☐ All prerequisites must be completed with a grade of 'C' or better
 - For the foreign language requirement, if taken in high school, coursework must be a passing grade; if taken in college, student must earn a grade of C or higher
- ☐ Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale at the time of application *and*
- ☐ Minimum science GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale at the time of application
- ☐ **At least three of the four required sciences must be completed prior to application:**
 - The four required sciences are Chemistry, Microbiology, Human Anatomy, and Human Physiology.
 - Each attempt of any of the four required science courses taken will be calculated into the science GPA.
 - Introductory Biology course(s) will **not** be calculated as part of the science GPA.
 - BIOL 1124 is not a prerequisite to the Nursing program; it is only a prerequisite for the OU Human Anatomy and Human Physiology courses. If equivalent Anatomy and Physiology courses are taken outside of OU, BIOL 1124 may not be required.

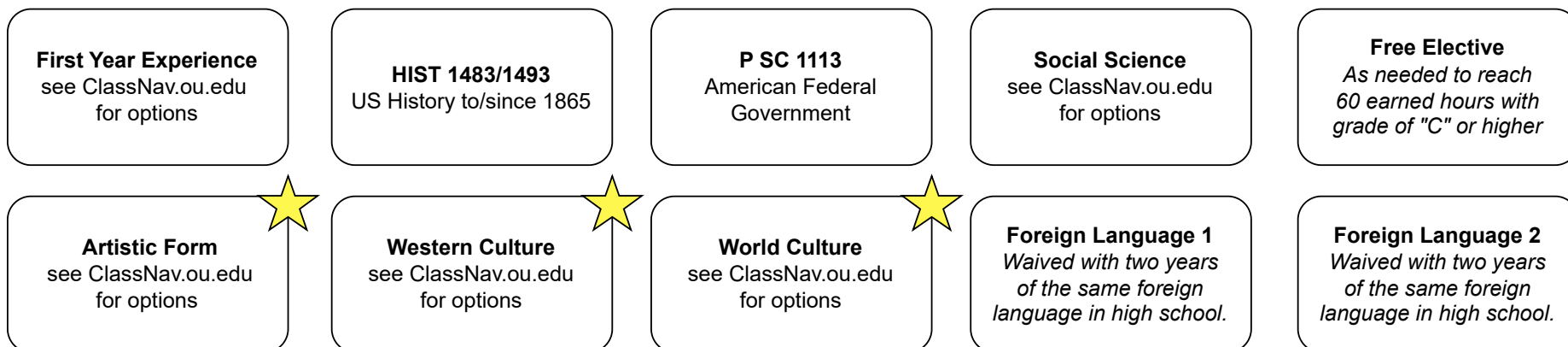
Note that the OU Health Campus does not recognize academic forgiveness or reprieve policies. All attempts of a course are included in the calculation of both the overall and science GPA.
