

## **RN-BSN**

Below are the required prerequisite courses for the RN-BSN program. Prerequisite courses are not required to be completed at time of application, but must be completed **prior** to BSN enrollment if admitted. All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of C or better, and applicants must have a minimum of one science prerequisite completed at time of application to calculate science GPA. Minimum last 60 credit hour (letter graded) and science GPA's to be eligible is 2.50.

## General Education courses required for all applicants, except:

- Items I-5 may be waived for those with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree from an Oklahoma college or a Bachelor's degree or higher. Not waived for out-of-state associate degrees or Associate of Applied Science.
- Item 4 may also be met by two semesters of the same language in College or two years of the same language in High School. A High School Transcript may be required.
- Item 6 may only be waived with a Bachelor's degree or higher.
