The NEW HESI advance placement exam cycle is now open!

Five HESI placement exams must be completed prior to **June 30, 2025**, for the LPN to BSN program. You have *four attempts* to meet the HESI benchmark score of 800 (~75%).

5 HESI Exam Content Areas

HESI Fundamentals of Nursing
HESI Maternity / Pediatrics
HESI Medical / Surgical
HESI Pathophysiology
HESI Pharmacology

HESI Exam + ProctorU bundle Cost:

\$70.00 per exam area. Each attempt will be an additional \$70. (**\$70 live online proctor ONLY**).

Exam Testing schedule:

* You must alternate the exam version that you attempt.

Example: **If you take Exam A as the first attempt, you will take Exam B as the second attempt.**
If you take Exam B as the first attempt, you will take Exam A as the second attempt.

*All passing scores will carry over to the next academic semester. If a maximum of all 4 attempts are unsuccessful, you are not eligible for admission. You must reapply for the program next cycle.

*If you have taken RN standardized HESI exams in the 5 listed content areas above from other institutions, please notify the student affairs office for further information. nursing@ouhsc.edu

Not meeting the benchmark: You will have **four attempts per exam for the admission cycle** to meet the HESI benchmark score of 800 (~75%). All passing scores will carry over to the next academic semester. If a maximum of all attempts is unsuccessful, you must reapply for the program.

Study Suggestions: Elsevier recommends two options; however, these study options are **not required**. You may choose your own preparatory material. The HESI exams will contain Next Generation NCLEX (NGN) testing strategies.
