

Below are the required prerequisite courses for the RN-BSN program. Prerequisite courses are not required to be completed at the time of application, but must be completed **prior** to BSN enrollment if admitted. All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of C or better, and applicants must have a minimum of one science prerequisite completed at the time of application to calculate their science GPA. The minimum last 60 credit hours (letter-graded) and science GPA to be eligible is 2.50.

General Education courses are required for all applicants, except:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Items 1-5 may be waived for those with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree from an Oklahoma college or a Bachelor’s degree or higher. Not waived for out-of-state associate degrees or Associate of Applied Science. Item 4 may also be met by two semesters of the same language in College or two years of the same language in High School. A High School Transcript may be required. Item 5 is an OU-specific course and is considered a graduation requirement rather than a prerequisite. This is the only requirement that can be completed while enrolled in the program if you do not complete the requirement before starting the program. Item 6 may only be waived with a Bachelor’s degree or higher.
