## TrADITIONAL BSN

Below are the required prerequisite courses for the Traditional BSN program. Prerequisite courses are not required to be completed at the time of application, but must be completed prior to BSN enrollment if admitted. All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of $C$ or better, and applicants must have a minimum of one science prerequisite completed at the time of application to calculate their science GPA. The minimum cumulative and science GPA to be eligible is 2.50 .
