

Below are the required prerequisite courses for the Traditional BSN program. Prerequisite courses are not required to be completed at time of application, but must be completed **prior** to BSN enrollment if admitted. All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of C or better, and applicants must have a minimum of one science prerequisite completed at time of application to calculate science GPA. Minimum cumulative and science GPA's to be eligible is 2.50.
