NURSE TECH APPLICATION

The Nurse Technician program at DRH Health is for nursing students who want to experience the fundamentals of nursing. The program will begin in June following completion of the first year of the ADN or BSN nursing program. It is an eight-week program that is tailored to the nursing students' interests. Nurse techs are rotated through several nursing departments and are assigned to a registered nurse preceptor to enhance their learning experience.



INSIGHT

This program provides insight into procedures, surgeries, teamwork, and patient experiences that help to reduce the anxiety that can come when new graduate nurses enter the workforce. RN preceptors will guide you through this experience, and help you make the most of your Summer Nurse Technician PAID Internship.



ORIENTATION

After onboarding with DRH, there will be a **MANDATORY** orientation May 28 & May 29, 2025.



WHO CAN APPLY

Nursing students who have successfully completed their first year of an accredited ADN or BSN program, and are enrolled in good standing for their sophomore or senior year. Preference is given to those students who possess a GPA of greater than 3.0 in their nursing courses. Work recommendations are to be able to work at least 24 - 36 hours per week.
