

LPN-BSN

Below are the required prerequisite courses for the LPN to BSN program. Prerequisite courses are not required to be completed at the time of application but must be completed before BSN enrollment if admitted. All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of C or better, and applicants must have a minimum of two science prerequisites completed at the time of application to calculate their science GPA. The minimum cumulative and science GPA to be eligible is 2.50.

General Education courses are required for all applicants, except:

Items 1-5 may be waived for those with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree from a public regionally accredited Oklahoma college or a bachelor's degree or higher. Not waived for out-of-state associate degrees or Associate of Applied Science.

3000-4000 Level GEN. ED. (must be listed as "Gen. Ed." On the Equivalency Charts) (3 credit hours)

- Item 4 may also be met by two semesters of the same language in college or two years of the same language in High School. A High School Transcript may be required.
- Item 5 is an OU-specific course and is considered a graduation requirement rather than a prerequisite. This is the only requirement that can be completed while enrolled in the program if you do not complete the requirement before starting the program.
- Item 6 may only be waived with a bachelor's degree or higher.

Total Credit Hours/Electives: Must have 61 total, earned transfer (non-BSN level) hours

NOTICE: Recommended to complete Anatomy & Physiology 1 & 2 at the same institution. All natural science courses are included in the science GPA. Prerequisite requirements and/or requirements for admission are subject to change and are not binding for admission. Applicants must meet the requirements for the current catalog year. It is the student's responsibility to stay informed of current admission requirements.

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
